Are You Ready?

Leadership Camp gives you opportunities to gain the knowledge and skills needed to perform your Student Council jobs effectively and develop the personal qualities you need to efficiently deal with others in your school. These skills will not only help improve your Student Council, but they will also be skills you can use throughout your life.

Exciting daily activities

While at camp, you will be assigned to camp councils. Each council elects officers, establishes committees and has camp activities to complete. Each day, you attend general sessions covering topics such as Parliamentary Procedure, Project Planning, Job Training and much more. Daily recreation activities include a volleyball tournament, basketball, swimming, boating, archery and crafts. Evening activities include a dance, a formal banquet, and other special events. Every day ends with a time to reflect and sing around a campfire.



Experienced, fun staff

In building the camp program and staff, the Camp Director chooses the best teachers and students Illinois has to offer. The Senior Staff is made up of teachers, many of whom are Student Council advisors. The Junior Counselor staff defines high energy and leadership. These high school students have been involved in Student Council and are actively involved in leadership roles in their schools. And, they all have been through the camp program. There is also a full-time Camp Nurse.



Register with a friend

You may attend the IAJHSC Summer Leadership Camp as a junior high/middle school student if your school is a member of the IAJHSC. There is no limit on the number of students your school may send. If you have already attended camp before your seventh grade year and you are still involved in Student Council, you may return to camp before your eighth grade year. Admission to camp is on a "first come-first served" basis until camp session has reached capacity.



Comfortable, safe cabins

While at camp, you are assigned to live in cabins with other junior high students and one or two Junior Counselors. Every cabin has bunk beds with comfortable mattresses. You will need to bring your own bedding.

Register for camp today!

The fee for the IAJHSC Summer Camp is \$300.00 per camper which covers the camp program, lodging and food for the week. Registration is done online before May 10th and camp payments are due no later than May 24, 2018. At no time during camp may campers leave and return to camp. Late arrivals will not be admitted.
